Vocabulary Exercises: matching, sentence completion, gap-fill, identifying

Speaking Activities: asking and answering questions, controlled and freer practice (pair work)

## **Focus**

Birthdays

## Aim

To learn and practice birthday vocabulary.

# **Preparation**

Make one copy of the two-page worksheet for each student.

### Level

Elementary (A1-A2)

#### Time

25 minutes

## Introduction

This birthdays worksheet helps students learn and practice common birthday-related vocabulary.

#### Procedure

Give each student a copy of the two-page worksheet.

First, students discuss two questions about birthdays.

Students then match birthday vocabulary from a box with pictures.

Exercise B - Answer key

Next, students match verbs with nouns to create common birthday phrases.

After that, students complete sentences about birthdays with their own ideas and then compare their answers with a partner.

Lastly, students ask and answer birthday conversation questions in pairs.




